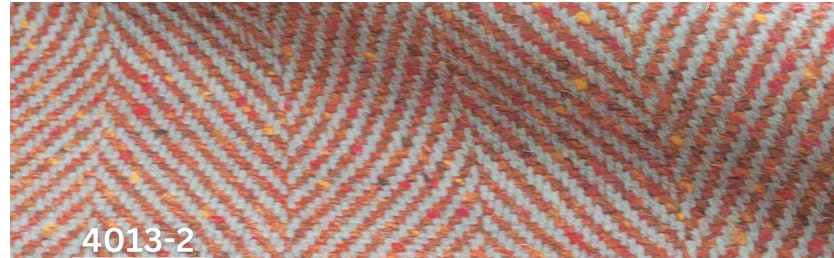


A B E R D E E N
